

# INFLATION REDUCTION ACT (IRA) CONT.

2. The *Home Efficiency Rebate Program* incentivizes whole-home retrofits in single-family and multifamily dwelling units. Rebate amounts increase as energy savings increase and are doubled for low-income households.

3. The *Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund* will make grants to drive low-cost financing for climate and clean-energy projects, especially in disadvantaged communities. It sets aside \$7 billion for Solar-for-All, a program to expand existing or support new low-income solar programs nationwide.

*\*Although these funds are not yet available, EveryHome will keep consumers updated on the Dept. of Energy's progress.*

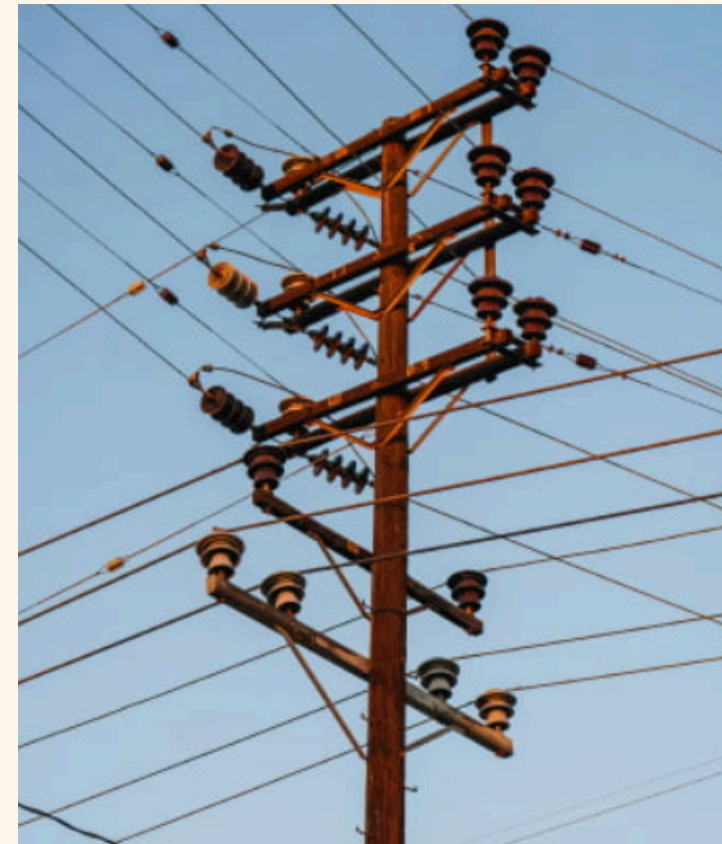

# INFLATION REDUCTION ACT (IRA)

---

The IRA is landmark legislation that plans to lower energy costs, increases cleaner production, and reduces carbon emissions by roughly 40 percent by 2030.

## Here are 3 IRA Programs addressing energy costs:

1. *Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates* allocate funding to state energy offices for helping households electrify their homes. Available only to low- or moderate-income households.
